The Problem

- All hard drives eventually fail
- Test performed by BackBlaze.com:
 - Data center with 41,213 hard drives
 - Some drives had a 26% failure rate



Other Ways to Lose Your Data

- Computer failure
- Accidental deletion
- Computer loss or theft (especially laptops)
- Fire or flood
- Malware

Your computer has been locked!

Your computer has been locked due to suspicion of illegal content downloading and distribution.

Mentioned illegal content (414 Mb of video files) was automatically classified as child pornographic materials. Such actions, in whole or in part, violate following U.S. Federal Laws:

18 U.S.C. § 2251- Sexual Exploitation of Children (Production of child pornography)

18 U.S.C. § 2252- Certain activities relating to material involving the sexual exploitation of minors (Possession, distribution and receipt of child pornography)

18 U.S.C. § 2252A- certain activities relating to material constituting or containing child pornography

Any individual who violates, or attempts to violate, or conspires to violate mentioned laws shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment from 4 to 30 years and shall be fined up to \$250,000.



All suspicious files from your computer were transmitted to a special server and shall be used as evidences. Don't try to corrupt any data or unblock your account in an unauthorized way.


You case can be classified as occasional/unmotivated, according to title 17 (U. S. Code) § 512. Thus it may be closed without prosecution. Your computer all be unblocked automatically.

In order to resolve the site tion in an above-mentioned way you should pay a fine of \$300.

You Might Get Lucky #1

If the computer has failed but the hard drive is OK:

- A friend or computer shop can probably fish data off the hard drive
- Cost: \$0 couple hundred





Recover data from hard drive

You Might Get Lucky #2 (Sort of)

Even if the hard drive has failed:

- A data recovery service may be able to recover some or all of your data
- Very specialized work
- Very expensive

What Is a Backup?

- Backup: a copy of your data
- Ongoing process
- Most people don't make backups
- Nothing else will do



The Chain of Events

- 1. You back up your data regularly
- 2. Something bad happens
- 3. You fix the underlying problem
- 4. You *restore* your data
- 5. Rinse and repeat





Backup Strategy #1

Flash Drive or External Hard Drive

Copy Files to a Flash Drive or Ext. Hard Drive

- Make sure all important files are copied to an flash drive or external hard drive
- Easiest with synchronization software





Synchronization Software: SyncBack Free

 Looks for new/changed files and copies to flash drive or hard drive



Only copies files that are new or different

Backup to Ext. Hard Drive

A Few Points

- Have at least two flash drives/hard drives and alternate between them
- Store external drives a physically apart from your computer as possible
- Be sure to schedule your backups



Advantages / Disadvantages

Advantages to Flash Drive/Ext Hard Drive

- Fast
- Easy

Disadvantages to Flash Drive/Ext Hard Drive

Susceptible to fire/flood



Backup Strategy #2

Online Backup Service

Online Backup Services

- Software on your PC watches for files to change
- Changed files are copied to backup service over the Internet
- All data is encrypted



Free Online Backup Services

 You may be able to use a free service if you have a very small amount of data (less than 8 GB)

Paid Cloud Backup Services

- Enables you to back up huge amounts of data
- Most have plans for multiple computers

Advantages to Online Backups

- Very easy: Set it and forget it
- Immune to fire/flood

- Ongoing cost
- Initial backup can take days

Internet Backup with a Friend

Internet Backup with a Friend

- Free service with CRASHPLAN
- You and a friend back up to each others' computers
- Each computer must have enough disk space for all files
- Computers should be on most of the time
- Files are encrypted on other person's PC

Advantages to Internet Backup with a Friend

- Very easy: Set it and forget it
- Immune to fire/flood
- Versioning
- Free!

Disadvantages to Internet Backup with a Friend

- Disk storage
- Computers should be on most of the time
